What to bring:

CANVASES - one or two large, at least 18 x 24 up to 24 x 36

Several small 16x20 or 11x14; canvas board are ok too (for technique studies)

Acrylic paints of all sorts....from high artist quality to house paints

Pastels or oil crayons

Magic markers

Large paint brushes (cheap 2" brushes are ok - several), some foam brushes

your artist brushes, long handle are best

Mod Podge

A natural sponge

Some stencils if you have any

A foam roller and a piece of cardboard for rolling on

Palette knives and trowels, some with teeth, a large comb or a fork is nice, old charge cards are useful

A jar of sand

Glitter or small rocks / crushed crystals or other objects for inlay (organic ones are also great like pine needles, barks)

Drawing paper, pencil, scissors

Masking tape

Gallon jug

Rags and paper towels

Plastic like a clear shower curtain to place under the floor/ table as we will make a mess Recycled containers for water or mixing
