



## Blue Ridge Mountains Arts Association 2021 Photography National Juried Show

July 24 –August 28, 2021

Entry Deadline: April 10, 2021

You are invited to enter the Blue Ridge Mountains Arts Association (BRMAA) 2021 Photography National Juried Show. The 2021 BRMAA Photography National Juried Show is open to all photographers, both amateur and professional, and all original photographic media, including film and digital images. Cash prizes totaling \$3,000, including \$750 for Best of Show, will be awarded.

- Best of Show - \$750 (not eligible for another recognition)
- 1<sup>st</sup> Place in Nature - \$400    1<sup>st</sup> Place in Fine Art - \$400    1<sup>st</sup> Place in Digital Art - \$400

This national show will proudly be on display in the Richard Low Evans Gallery of the Art Center, home to the Blue Ridge Mountains Arts Association and located at the historic courthouse in Blue Ridge, Georgia from July 24 through August 28, 2021.

The judge for this year's show is **Eric Dusenbery**. Eric Dusenbery (B.A. Cinema & Photography, Southern Illinois University) is passionate about using curiosity and photography to tell stories.

Eric's photography and writing has appeared in numerous publications and he is the recipient of several national awards. Eric works with clients on their visual communications needs. By using unconventional thinking and curiosity to remove the jargon associated with many traditional approaches, the resulting work helps clients to stand out and engage audiences.

In addition to assignments and commissions, Eric uses photography and storytelling for a variety of social and cultural issues — to enrich and preserve the human spirit and to promote an appreciation for the rich cultural identity of the South. Photographs from projects have been widely exhibited from traditional fine-art galleries and museums to educational and cultural centers.

For many projects, Eric chooses to work with film, including the large format 4 x 5 view camera with black-and-white materials. He is drawn to the rich, tonal range that film/paper provides and the experience of traditional photography with careful consideration of composition. In the field, using the 4 x 5 camera requires patience, self-discipline and control. It's an old-school approach, but it can be the ultimate tool for capturing details. In the darkroom, he hand prints each piece, utilizing techniques to enhance and intensify the images.

Whether maneuvering among the rafters in a historic clock tower or crouched in a cooler on a shrimp boat, Eric's photographic escapades and stories make us eager to begin living a life of curiosity.

**Entry Requirements:      Note: Entry Requirements have changed; please read carefully.**

- The entry fee for each image is \$10. There is no limit to the number of entries per photographer.
  - All images of **one** photographer may be submitted on one CD or USB flash drive and all entries may be included in one envelope. Each image must have its own entry form.
- Entries must be designated as Nature, Fine Art or Digital Art on the entry form.
  - The **Nature** category includes, but is not limited to: wildlife, landscapes, waterscapes, plant materials and abstracts in nature. Work submitted in the Nature category must have no elements of mankind (which include but are not limited to buildings, fences, roads, and signs) and cannot be subject composites. Stitched panoramas and focus stacking will be accepted. Only images that have **not** been changed beyond basic processing-- such as color, exposure, saturation and contrast adjustment --will be accepted. Spot removal and cropping is also allowed.
  - The **Fine Art** category includes, but is not limited to cityscapes, landscapes (including structures), portraits, and floral or plant life. Focus stacking, and stitched panoramas are acceptable in this category. Subject composites will **not** be accepted. Only images that have **not** been changed beyond basic processing-- such as color, exposure, saturation and contrast adjustment --will be accepted. Spot removal and cropping is also allowed.
  - The **Digital Art** category includes abstract subject and images originally created with the camera and is altered in post processing including subject matter that is identifiable or not easily identifiable with post processing. Combined multiple exposures for HDR, art techniques, focus stacking, and stitched panoramas are allowed in this category.
- Digital images of the work to be submitted should be in the form of **JPEG files on CD or USB flash drive**. Images should be approximately 1000 pixels on the longest side and print quality (320ppi or better). Raw files may be requested by the jurors. **All images must have metadata intact or will be disqualified**. Notes about the image and/or its processing may be included in 25 words or less with the entry form (see last page of pdf).
  - In the case of images captured on film, photographer must provide the pertinent metadata in the 'processing notes' section of the entry form. This would include notes on any post-processing that may have occurred, as well as the capture date, camera make and model, lens model, shutter speed, ISO and aperture combination used. Please mark the front of your entry as a 'film' entry, which will alert our forensics team to review the processing notes.
- All image files must be entitled with photographer's last name, first initial and the entry's title (Smith, J. Picture of a Horse). The entry's title must match the title and photographers name that appears on the entry form.
- All entries must be an original photograph taken by the submitting photographer **on or after April 1, 2018**. No submissions of previous or currently pending submissions for any juried show in the Art Center will be accepted.

- Submitted images will be viewed by jurors who will select the photographs accepted for the Show. The accepted entries will be judged on technical and artistic merits as determined by the judge, who will choose the prize winners.
- The copyright of submitted images remains with the photographer. By signing the entry form, the photographer agrees to allow BRMAA to publish the image on websites, social media and printed materials and to use the image in promotions for this and future contests without compensation.
- Complete the official entry form for each image and **make a copy for your records**. Sign the form and mail or hand-deliver to the address below. Be sure to include the CD or USB flash drive, which will not be returned.
- Include a check or money order payable to **Blue Ridge Mountains Arts Association (BRMAA)** for the appropriate amount.
- Notification of acceptance and/or non-acceptance will be sent by **EMAIL only** no later than June 18, 2021; if you have not received an email by this date, please check your spam/trash folder. Please make sure your correct email address is included and legible on the entry form. To ensure the email is not blocked, add **blueridgearts.photoshow@gmail.com** to your address book.

### Submitting Accepted Work

Successfully juried entries must meet the following print criteria to be hung and judged: The **only** acceptable forms of display are photographs that have been matted and framed behind glass or acrylic, printed on canvas and gallery wrapped (framed or unframed), metal or acrylic prints, or professionally mounted on gatorboard. If the mounted form of display is **not wired for hanging it is not acceptable**. Matted-only pieces are **not** acceptable. Signature(s) are acceptable on either the image or matte. Hanging methods other than wiring **cannot** be used. Photographs that do not meet these criteria will **not** be accepted into the Show.

The photographer's name, the work's title and price must be on the back of each finished piece and must match the information on the entry form. A copy of the entry form may be used on the back of each finished piece. No entry may be larger than **48" x 48"** (including mat and frame) or smaller than **11" x 14"**. (**Note** that the total area of panoramas must be a minimum of 154 square inches and no greater than 2304 square inches and the outside dimensions must not exceed 48 inches on either side.) Entries that are **shipped must have acrylic glazing**. Glass is permitted in entries hand delivered to the Art Center.

All work submitted **must be for sale**. A sales commission of 35% (30% for BRMAA members) will be retained by BRMAA for all work sold during the course of the show. The 7% Georgia sales tax will be added at the point of sale. All work **must** remain in the gallery through the Show dates unless sold through BRMAA.

**Hand deliver** uncrated photographs to the Blue Ridge Mountains Arts Association, 420 West Main Street, Blue Ridge, Georgia, only on July 16, 2021, from 11 am - 4 pm. Hand delivered work must be picked up August 29, 2021, from 11 am - 4 pm.

**Shipped** photographs should be sent by **UPS** or **FedEx**, with a prepaid return label, to Blue Ridge Mountains Arts Association, c/o 2021 Photography NJS, 420 West Main Street, Blue Ridge, Georgia 30513. Accepted work should arrive at the Art Center between July 6 and July 16, 2021. No deliveries on Monday. A handling fee of **\$15 per box**, payable to Blue Ridge Mountains Arts Association (BRMAA), is required. The handling fee must be included with the photographs or they will **not** be included in the Show. Only the accepted entries of **one** photographer can be shipped in the same container. The name on the return address label must match the name on the back of each piece in the box as well as the name on the entry form. **Please remember to enclose your prepaid return shipping label inside your container along with a check for the handling fee.**

### **Liability**

Neither the Blue Ridge Mountains Arts Association, their successors and/or assigns, nor their representatives will be held responsible for lost or damaged CDs or photographs. All reasonable precautions will be taken to ensure protection of submitted work upon receipt. No liability can be assumed by BRMAA during the Show or storage for damage incurred or loss of work while in transit or at the show. Artists are advised to arrange their own shipping and Show insurance. There is a \$30 returned check fee for any NSF/ returned check payment(s).
