During the month of March, the Blue Ridge Mountains Arts Association, Fannin County High School, and artist Pamela Beagle-Daresta are partnering to provide the "Creative Expressions Program" made possible by the 2016 Vibrant Communities Grant from the Georgia Council for the Arts. The program will include multiple mixed media printmaking workshop sessions at Fannin County High School (FCHS) and the Art Center, free of charge, during Youth Art Month. This venture will include a one-week artist residency with FCHS, a professional development workshop for area educators relating to the visual arts and S.T.E.A.M. curriculum, a master printmaking class at the Art Center, and to

culminate the week-long program, a student works exhibit will also be hosted at the Art Center.

Pamela Beagle-Daresta will be our artist in residence for this week-long program. Pamela is certified in Discipline-Based Arts Education and Talents Unlimited with training in Artful Learning and art therapy. She specializes in creating residencies that educationally connect with curriculum. She has a wide audience appeal based on her credentials and her visual hands-on and professional development experience. The Creative Expressions Program will be held March 22-25.
